

## ANCILLARY PROCEDURES CONSENT FORM

Your pet is scheduled for a procedure that requires anesthesia and, like you, our greatest concern is the well being of your pet. Before putting your pet under anesthesia, we will perform a full physical examination to identify any existing medical conditions that could complicate the procedure and compromise the health of your pet. However, many conditions, including disorders of the liver, kidney or blood are not detected unless blood testing is performed. Such tests are especially important before any kind of surgery.

For these reasons, we highly recommend a pro-anesthetic blood screen before such procedures. The tests we recommend are similar to and equally as important as those your own physician would run if you were to undergo anesthesia. Results will be immediately available to examine before anesthesia and/or surgery.

### PAIN MANAGEMENT

Pain control has recently advanced in the field of veterinary medicine and we now have new medications that can greatly help your pet to be more comfortable after their surgery. We will give your pet an analgesic injection immediately after the surgery and pain medication will be sent home. There is an additional charge of \$20.00

### MICROCHIP/TATTOO

We recommend this form of permanent identification in case your pet is lost or stolen. It is quite easily done while your pet is under anesthesia.
